[13655-25](#) A Resolution approving a project for the benefit of Heritage Valley Health System, Inc., a nonprofit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Borrower"), to be financed by the Allegheny County Hospital Development Authority (the "Authority") by the issuance of the Authority's tax-exempt and/or taxable bonds, in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$95,000,000 (the "Bonds"), provided that the taxing power of the County of Allegheny, Pennsylvania (the "County") shall not be obligated in any way with respect to the Bonds, and declaring the financing of such project as desirable for the health, safety, and welfare of the people in the area where the facilities being financed are located.
